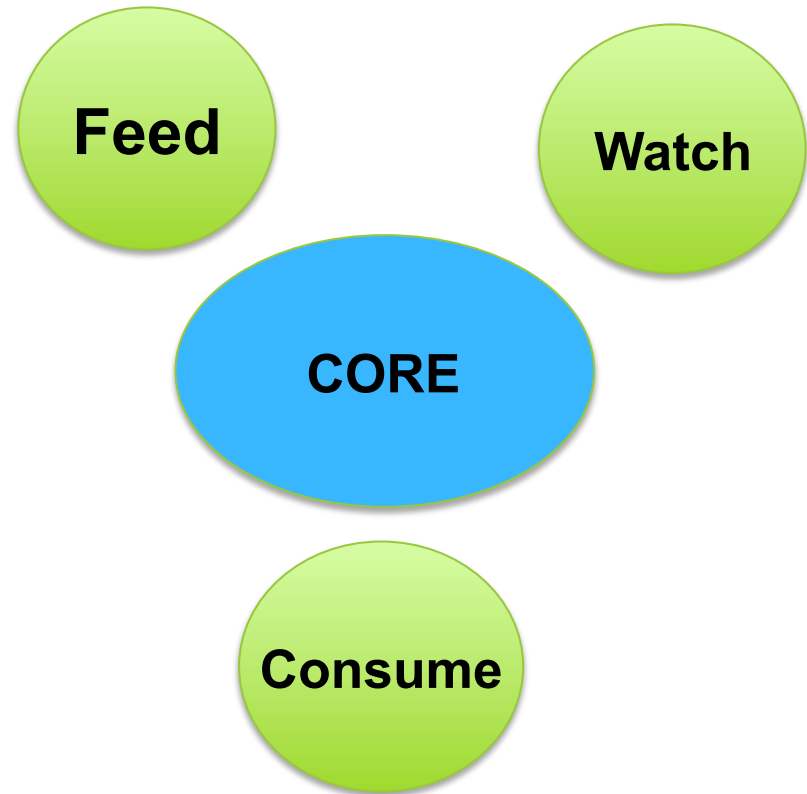
Open Source Myths & Reality

Alfresco Model

- 2 Versions (Community and Enterprise)
- Community -> Mostly consumers. Contributions are mostly add-ons, feed-back, testing, ideas etc.
- **ALL** CORE development done by Alfresco



Alfresco Model

- BOTH Alfresco versions (Community & Enterprise) are developed, controlled and managed by Alfresco core Engineering team
- ONLY Alfresco (the company) can release Alfresco (the product) versions, Community version & Enterprise version
